

Job Title: Support Worker

- Relevant qualifications in health and social care, such as NVQ/QCF Level 2 or 3 in Health and Social Care/children and young people, or willingness to work towards obtaining the required qualifications.
- Knowledge and understanding of person-centred approaches, safeguarding principles, and relevant legislation regarding the care of individuals with Learning Disabilities, Autism, and Mental Health Needs.
- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written, with the ability to build rapport and maintain professional boundaries.
- Empathy, patience, and the ability to remain calm and composed in challenging situations.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team, demonstrating flexibility and adaptability to meet the changing needs of service users.
- Basic IT skills to use electronic care planning systems and maintain accurate records.
